The **Adopt-A-Child Christmas Program** provides warm clothing and toys to more than 3500 children each year. The mission of the program is simple: to match needy children with individuals and organizations who are willing to purchase gifts and / or make a monetary gift to the program. The gifts are given directly to the children by the “adoptive” parents, during a large Christmas party at Cobo Center.

Without the Adopt-A-Child Christmas party, many children would have nothing to look forward to during the holiday season. All of the Adopt-A-Child recipients are pre-screened by their parent’s social security number, which ensures they are truly in need of assistance.

Putting on an event of this magnitude would be impossible without corporate and individual support. The cost of the event is roughly about \$30,000, which includes the rental of Cobo Center as well as a box lunch for each child the night of the party.

About the Adopt-A-Child Program

Helps disadvantaged children from newborn to age 12 by providing them with:

- **A warm winter coat or jacket**
- **Two warm outfits**
- **At least one age-appropriate toy**
- **Other gifts or toys optional**

Sponsors get the opportunity to:

- Be a part of a celebration, which brings together people of all races and religions from all over metro Detroit
- Mentor a young child through conversation and interest
- See their generosity in action—putting a smiles on the faces of children
- Contributions are tax deductible
- Sponsors receive information on the child or family they wish to adopt
- Sponsors are encouraged to meet the children at the party and present

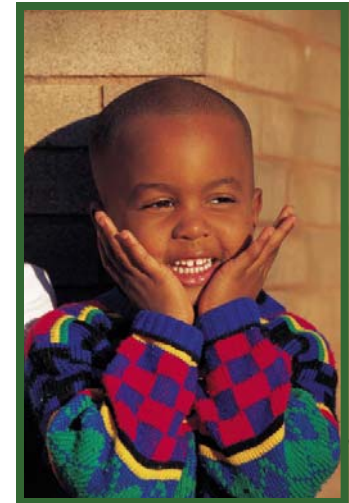


The North End Youth Improvement Council
